BACKGROUND

behind developing CBP ROAMTM



CHALLENGE

Low compliance rates and lack of travelers reporting U.S. Entry are due to:

- Outdated, reporting systems such as Outlying Area Reporting Systems (OARS)
- Long wait times at Ports of Entry to report arrival along the Southern Border
- Disparate Ports of Entry along the Norther Border



OPPORTUNITY

U.S. coastal waters are frequented by a compliant population of pleasure boaters looking for an easier way to report



SOLUTION

CBP ROAM is a mobile application that...

- Allows travelers to report their U.S. entry through a smartphone or tablet
- Transforms how the Office of Field Operations
 (OFO) processes low-risk travelers by reducing manual data entry
- Enables targeted enforcement and increases compliant travel
- Is developed for the Field, by the Field



BENEFITS

of using CBP ROAM to process pleasure boaters:

inspection quality and Officer safety through advanced scanning capabilities

traveler screening through integrated targeting systems

processing time by reducing manual data entry performed by Officers and travelers

FUTURE FUNCTIONALITY

will improve traveler processing in addition operating environments



CBP is currently piloting the use of CBP ROAM for **bus processing**, another mode of travel that will benefit from advanced submission of arriving travelers, enhanced targeting, and the elimination of manual data entry.



CBP is exploring **additional use cases** where CBP ROAM can be used to expedite processing of known and compliant travelers.
