

Pilot project on digitalisation of travel documents and facilitation of travel




Objectives

The pilot project will support the legislative process by feeding into the impact assessment, achieving proof of concept and exploring the legal, economic, security and other impacts of digitalising travel documents at EU level and facilitating travel.

To test and pilot the creation, submission and inspection of the DTC, the verification of identity at the border and measure the effectiviness, efficiency and security of using a DTC for crossing external borders.
