The mythological hero, **Prometheus**, was Jupiter's son. He defied the gods by stealing fire from them and giving it to Humanity in order to improve their life on Earth. This story told by **Hesiod** in his *Theogony* is depicted in Ruben's sketch. Here, the artist captures the moment when, fleeing from heavenly Olympus, **Prometheus** looks back. Behind him, the ire of the gods is insinuated by the sunbeams that shine through the clouds, later producing the terrible punishment the protagonist is to suffer. **Rubens** made this panel as a sketch for one of the paintings for the **Torre de la Parada**, which was executed by **Jan Cossiers**.
