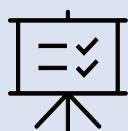

In 2025, the majority of training activities – **82%** – were delivered online: 21 webinars, 5 online modules and 2 online courses. The most popular format was webinars, **attracting 1740 participants**, with an average **satisfaction rate of 89%**, up from 86% in 2024.

Although only 6 activities were **delivered face-to-face** to law enforcement authorities Member States, these trainings were **rated most favourably** by participants, reaching a satisfaction rate of **92%**.

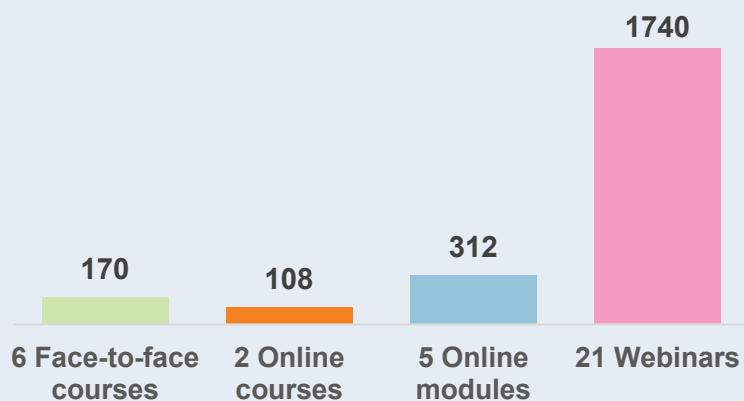


Figure 1: Training activities and participants per delivery mode

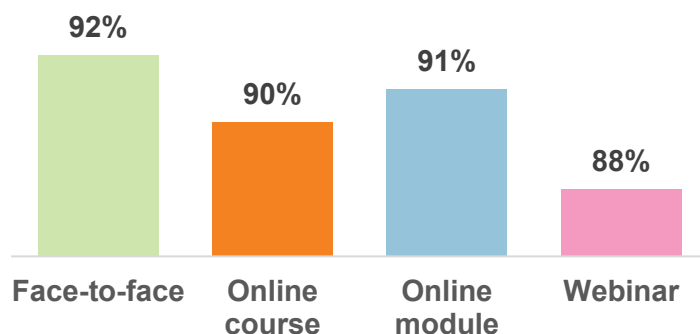


Figure 2: Satisfaction rate with the activities per delivery mode

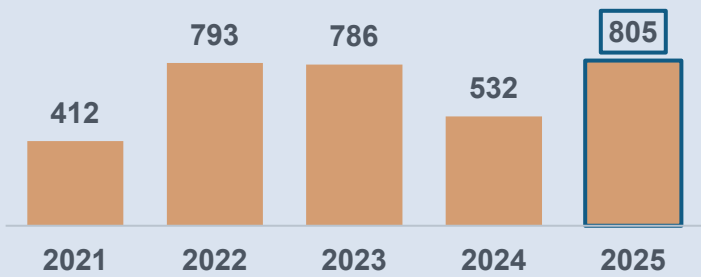


Figure 3: New LMS accounts 2021 - 2025

For the past 4 years, eu-LISA's LMS has maintained a **high level of user satisfaction – 89%.**

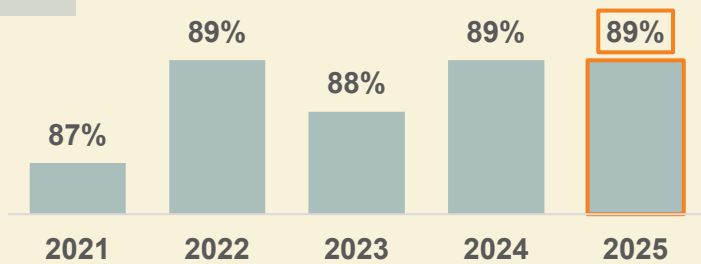


Figure 4: User satisfaction with eu-LISA LMS.

By the end of 2025, eu-LISA's Learning Management System comprised **120 digital training resources**, which are **available for self-enrolment to authorised users in Member States and JHA agencies.**

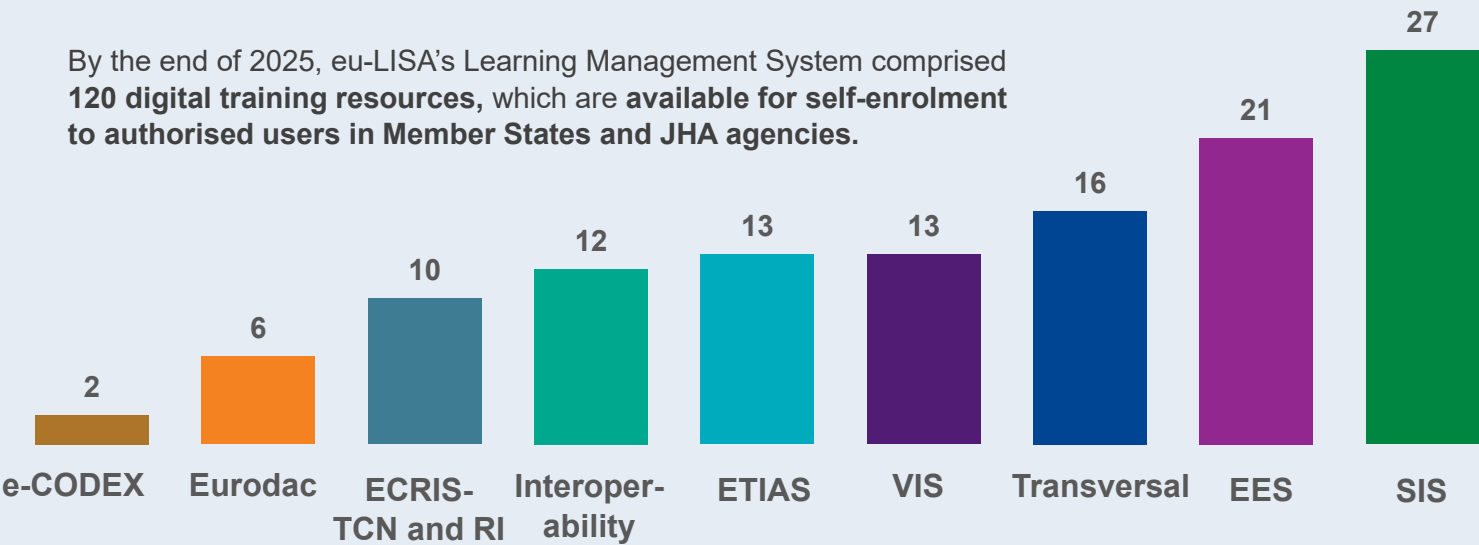


Figure 5: Number of digital learning resources available on LMS per system.
